Cap and Gown Pickup

Pick up your cap and gown at the Austin Convention Center, Level 3 in the Ballroom ABC Foyer, Friday, June 11 from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. and Saturday, June 12, 7:30 a.m. -1 p.m., Level 4 in the Ballroom D-G Foyer. *Note: LLSR recipients do not wear caps and gowns. LLSR recipients should dress in business attire to accept their pin onstage.*

Convocation Rehearsal

Rehearsal will be Saturday, June 12, at 3:30 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. at the Austin Convention Center, Level 4, Ballrooms D-G. The Convocation ceremony will begin at 4:30 p.m. You must bring your cap and gown to the rehearsal. You WILL NOT have time to pick it up after rehearsal. You will receive your seat assignment for the Convocation ceremony approximately two weeks before the meeting via e-mail. Please make sure we have a valid e-mail for you to prevent delay.

Convocation Ceremony

The Convocation ceremony will be on Saturday, June 12, at 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Austin Convention Center Level 4 Ballrooms D-G. Due to the pandemic, capacity is limited, and tickets will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. *Awardees and LLSR recipients may reserve one guest ticket for seating in the convention center ballroom*. Additional guest tickets can be reserved to view the livestreamed ceremony in Hilton Hotel Ballroom. **Reserve guest tickets with your meeting registration.**

Guests at the Convocation Ceremony

Guests attending only the Convocation ceremony are NOT required to register for the AGD 2021 Scientific Meeting. Doors open at 4:15 p.m. Due to the pandemic guest seating is limited. Awardees and LLSR recipients can reserve one guest ticket for entrance into Ballroom D-G when they register for the meeting. ALL guests,

including children in strollers, must have a ticket to enter Ballroom D-G. Additional guest seating will be available in the Hilton Ballroom where guests will be able to watch the ceremony on large screens. Awardees and LLSR recipients must reserve tickets for additional guests when they register. Tickets for seating at the Hilton will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Oral Cancer Screenings
